This complaint against the officer(s) named or identified will be thoroughly investigated by the Chief of Police or designee. You will receive written notice regarding the disposition of your complaint within 30 days. The investigation may be extended if deemed necessary by the Chief of Police.

Please be advised, by falsely reporting a crime or alleged misconduct against a Police Officer(s), the complainant or potential witness(s) may be subject to being criminally charged under Minnesota State Statue, 609.505 subdivision 2.

REPORTING POLICE MISCONDUCT:

- (a) Whoever informs, or causes information to be communicated to, a peace officer, whose responsibilities include investigating or reporting police misconduct, that a peace officers, as defined in section 626.84, subdivision 1, paragraph (c), has committed an act of police misconduct, knowing that the information is false, is guilty of a crime and may be sentenced as follows:
 - (1) Up to the maximum provided for a misdemeanor if the false information does not allege a criminal act; or
 - (2) Up to the maximum provided for a gross misdemeanor if the false information alleges a criminal act.
- (b) The court shall order any person convicted of a violation of this subdivision to make full restitution of all reasonable expenses incurred in the investigation of the false allegation unless the court makes a specific written findings that restitution would be inappropriate under the circumstances. A restitution award may not exceed \$3,000.
