## CARES Act Tribal Member Assistance

### Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where can I pick up the application?
  - The application is available on the White Earth website at: [www.whiteearth.com](http://www.whiteearth.com)
  - Some local businesses have printed applications available for Tribal Members
2. Will there be a drop box where Tribal Members can drop off their completed forms?
  - No. Completed applications must be mailed on or before September 30, 2020 to:  
**White Earth Enrollments**  
**P.O. Box 506**  
**White Earth, MN 56591**
3. Can I fill out the application online?
  - Yes, however you will still need to print the completed form to have it notarized and mail it in to the address above.
4. Will I need identification?
  - Yes, you will need **currently valid identification** to present to the notarial officer if the notarial officer does not personally know you.
  - It is safest to bring nonexpired identification with you when you have your application notarized.
  - For Minnesota notarial officers, acceptable forms of identification include, but are not limited to:
    - ✓ passport; driver's license; tribal identification card; Minnesota identification card; military identification card.
5. Where and when can I access a Notary?
  - The Bingo Hall in Mahnomen, MN has a notarial official
  - Some banks and county offices offer notary services
