- WHEREAS, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee is the duly elected governing body of the White Earth Reservation pursuant to Article VI, Section 1, of the revised constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, as amended, and organized under Section 16, of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984), and
- WHEREAS, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee is the duly authorized governing body of the White Earth Band, and
- WHEREAS, the City of Mahnomen requests to enter into a joint powers agreement with the White Earth Band of Ojibwe pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Sections 436.05 (joint powers agreements) and 471.59 (contracts for police services), and
- WHEREAS, the White Earth Band of Ojibwe exercises law enforcement authority pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 626.93 through the White Earth Police Department, and
- WHEREAS, the City of Mahnomen desires to obtain the services of the White Earth Police
  Department to provide law enforcement within the boundaries of the City of
  Mahnomen through enforcement of city ordinances and the laws of the State of
  Minnesota for the public safety of their citizens, and
- WHEREAS, the White Earth Police Department has the capacity to enter into this agreement with the City of Mahnomen, now

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the White Earth Reservation Business Committee hereby approves the White Earth Public Safety Division to enter into a joint powers agreement for purposes of a police service contract with the City of Mahnomen.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the White Earth Reservation Business Committee hereby authorizes the Chairman, Secretary-Treasurer or Executive Director to enter into negotiations and to sign all necessary contracts and documents pending legal review for the above-stated purpose.
