- WHEREAS, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee is the duly elected governing body of the White Earth Reservation pursuant to Article VI, Section 1, of the revised constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, as amended, and organized under Section 16, of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984), and
- WHEREAS, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee is the duly authorized governing body of the White Earth Band, and
- WHEREAS, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee has a fiduciary responsibility in fiscal management of White Earth Nation funds, and
- WHEREAS, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee has a responsibility to support cultural activities by providing access to such activities for the benefit of the White Earth Nation, and
- whereas, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee intends to utilize a contractual relationship with the White Earth Powwow Committee or any similar associations for purposes of organizing White Earth Reservation Business Committee sponsored powwows, and
- WHEREAS, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee will utilize contracts in order to ensure fiscal responsibility and oversight of all sponsored powwows for the benefit of the White Earth Nation, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the White Earth Reservation Business Committee hereby adopts the practice of entering into powwow contracts with powwow committees and similar associations for the purposes of organizing White Earth Reservation Business Committee sponsored powwows, and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee powwow contracts will require an approved budget and documentation of all expenses for the purposes of ensuring fiscal responsibility and oversight of all White Earth Reservation Business Committee sponsored powwows.
