Resolution No. 055-24-002


- WHEREAS,** the White Earth Reservation Business Committee is the duly elected governing body of the White Earth Reservation pursuant to Article VI, Section 1, of the revised constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, as amended, and organized under Section 16, of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984), and
- WHEREAS,** the White Earth Reservation Business Committee also known as the White Earth Reservation Business Committee, is the duly authorized governing body of the White Earth Band; and
- WHEREAS,** it is the responsibility of White Earth Tribal Forestry to manage the forest resource in a healthy, productive and sustainable condition, and
- WHEREAS,** White Earth Tribal Forestry must submit a report annually to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, requesting non-recurring funding for forest development projects in the coming year, and
- WHEREAS,** this report is titled the "Forest Development Planned Projects/Activities Request", requesting a total of \$14,000.00, and
- WHEREAS,** any forest development proposed projects must be approved by the White Earth Reservation Business Committee before any work can proceed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the White Earth Reservation Business Committee hereby approves of the new proposed forest development projects for Fiscal Year 2024.

We do hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted by a vote of 3 for, 0 against, 0 silent, a quorum being present at a regular meeting of the White Earth Reservation Business Committee held on January 26, 2024 in Mahnomen, Minnesota.
